


## HNWA receives \$1,000 grant from Coweta-Fayette EMC's Operation Round Up



At the end of September, we got some exciting news from the Coweta-Fayette EMC Trust Board, and their **Operation Round Up** program is awarding us a \$1,000 grant that we will use to help fund writing contests that are open to aspiring authors ages 16 and over. 




