4. Accepted author(s) must supply their own canopy, table, chairs, and means of processing their book sales for the event.
5. Authors whose applications are accepted will be notified by e-mail by March 31 of their acceptance. To secure their spot, authors must then submit payment by April 15, along with additional materials to be outlined in the notification e-mail. Note: for shared booth applications, designate which Author will be responsible for payment. HNWA will not split billing.
